Math Stations:

We have started to show our thinking with our math work by using different strategies (tally marks, number line, counting up/back, drawing a picture, switching the partners, math mountains, writing equations, etc.). Writing just the answer is not enough! Encourage your child to always show two ways of thinking. We are also starting to dive into subtraction! Please see the parent videos online for strategies to help with showing work on homework

Literacy:

We have practiced re-reading books to gain better understanding and getting our minds ready to read (looking at the title, picture walk,

etc) in reader's workshop. We have been focusing on retelling a story using the words who, what, where, and why. It is important for students to list AND describe the characters, describe all the main settings, and explain the main idea.

Writer's Workshop:

We have begun to use our 1st quarter writing rubrics to check our writing and conventions. You can find these under writing on our class website. We have also started to use plans to stretch our writing even more with a beginning, middle, and end!

Science/Social Studies:

In Science, we have started our measurement unit and have learned how to measure with a starting and ending point. We've learned to use the words shortest, longest, height, and length when describing measurements of items. We have also learned to use the "type of units" when recording a measurement.
