Math Stations:

In math we have worked on making ten sticks and circles for 2-digit numbers, comparing numbers with greater than/less than symbols, and putting numbers in order based on their value. We also have practiced making equations that have the same total (4 + 8, 16 -4, 13 – 1, etc.)

Literacy.:

We practiced reading strategies of identifying major events in a story using "time words" (first, then, next, finally). We created a holiday ornament or decoration and then completed flow chart of how you would make the decoration using transition words. We also have been reading non-fiction texts about various holiday traditions and made connections of our own.

Writer's Workshop:

We have reviewed writing a beginning sentence, 3 details, and closing sentence as well as adding descriptive words to make writing exciting to read.

Science/Social

Studies:

We "traveled" around the world to learn how other people celebrate holidays. Our class toured Diwali, Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, and Ramadan and we'll study other countries and traditions next week as well. Have your child share their knowledge with you about traditions from the different countries we have visited. What a wonderful opportunity for students to develop a sense of understanding of how others' traditions may be different than theirs. Have your child choose one holiday tradition and compare and contrast that tradition from one in your own family



We have begun our new science unit on Organisms. We have been investigating different plant and animal life like Elodea and Cabomba, tree seedlings and moss, and guppies and snails.
