We have been putting the Covey Habit "Think Win-Win" to use in our classroom by striving for mutually beneficial agreements. We are showing that we value and respect one another.

Math Workshop:

We have extended our math learning the past two weeks by learning how to add and count up to 100 using a hundreds board. We are continuing to solve word problems, but have used our adding to 100 knowledge in adding up to \$1.00 or 100 cents. We have discussed that if we want something, we can find out how much we have to save!

Reader's Workshop:

In RW, we have been focusing heavily on what the Author's message is. We have discovered that all works have writing have the purpose to either entertain, persuade or inform. After reading a book, a class pole would be taken asking what they think the author's message is. Students were responsible for sharing details in the text to help support their decision.

Writer's Workshop:

In WS, we have begun to focus on conducting research and informative writing. Using synergy, each student and a partner created a lotus with information of a famous NC landmark. Each student then individually created their own travel brochure. This type of synergy-research will be continued when we research different star constillations! We are still focusing on capitalizing proper nouns. We are beginning to discuss space and placing appropriate spacing between words.

Science/Social Studies:

In S.S. we have discussed how North Carolina is divided into 3 regions based on how the land is leveled (mountains, piedmont, and coast). We have been



using synergy to create landmark brochures and Google Earth to understand the differences between a city, state, and country. We will be focusing on the moon phases during calendar time and doing a star constellation research project! In February, we will be doing a brand new Science Unit on Balance and Motion!

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


