Math Workshop:

In math we have been focusing on the different 100's partner, two numbers who's sum is 100. We have been using the partners of 10 to help us. We have used this knowledge to complete money word problems. Next week we will be starting to measure objects and record their data using a table or graph.

Reader's Workshop:

In RW, we have been focusing on inferencing when we read. 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


