In The Classroom:

Hello!

We have been thinking about the world and what goes on outside A.B. Combs. This has been emphasized through the Balance and Motion unit as well as learning about the world's habitats!

Math Workshop:

In math the students have been practicing solving simple math story problems and measuring various objects using a ruler and measuring by an inch. We have introduced the fraction ½ and ¼ to the students as well as their relationship.

Reader's Workshop:

In RW, it has been a wonderful experice learning about the rainforest environment. We have learned so much interesting and exciting information. We have discussed how non-fiction give us information while fiction books tells us a story. We have identified parts of nonfiction books such as table of contents, headings, etc. Discuss with your child the parts of a non-fiction

book and how our minds have to think differently while reading for imformation!

Writer's Workshop:

In WS, we have been working on adding details to our writing with good openeing and ending sentences. We discussed how this gives our reader (whoever is reading our writing) a good sense of closure. It's what great writers do! Students have also learned how important it is to record data. They have had a lot of experience doing this in their STEM notebook during the balance and motion unit.

Science/Social Studies:

We are beginning to wind down our Balance and Motion unit. Students have been using the Engineer Design Process to design, create, test and improve both rockets and sails. By going through this process, students have learned that it's fine to not create a perfect product the first time. We



have been emphasizing the process of improving our previous designs based on how they performed. We have also begun to learn about the world environments. The students have learned about the rainforest, its diverse animals, deforestation and what we can do (at A.B. Combs) to help protect it. Soon we will be learning about the Arctic and turning out classroom into the arctic tundra!

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
