We had a huge success with Leadership Day this month! The children sang beautifully for our guests and were very proud to be a part of the day!

Math Workshop:

In math we are continuing to learn about adding double digit numbers. We want the children to be able to show their work/thinking in different ways. Encourage your child to draw a "proof" drawing with ten sticks and circles (ones) for both of the numbers being added. Have them check to see if they can circle a group of ten to make it a ten-stick. Also practice the expanded method: 46 + 28 = 40 + 6 + 20 + 8 and drawing a picture to match.

Reader's Workshop:

In reading we have been discussing the main idea and author's message/lesson learned. We have been reading several fun books like "Michael Recycle" and "Mrs. Fox's Class Goes Green". We have also continued researching. We worked in groups to record our research and create a poster to present to the class about saving energy, saving water, taking care of our environment, and recycling!

Writer's Workshop:

In writing we have been reviewing how to write opinion/persuasive pieces. For leadership day, we learned about World Water Day and brainstormed ways we could save water here to help people in other places of the world. We learned how other families may be living without clean water and how that affects their lives. We took our information and wrote persuasive speeches to bring awareness about this global issue! Science/Social Studies:

We have been learning how to recycle, reduce, and reuse. We have used a flowchart and our transition words to create a step-by-step poster on how to re-create our "recycled" invention. We have had a blast using our imaginations!




