Math Stations:

We have been using math strategies to write numbers correctly, find "break apart line" for sets and write numbers to match, and identify numbers that can be partners to make a larger number (ex. 2 + 3 are partners that make 5). We also practiced our spatial reasoning with tangram puzzles.
