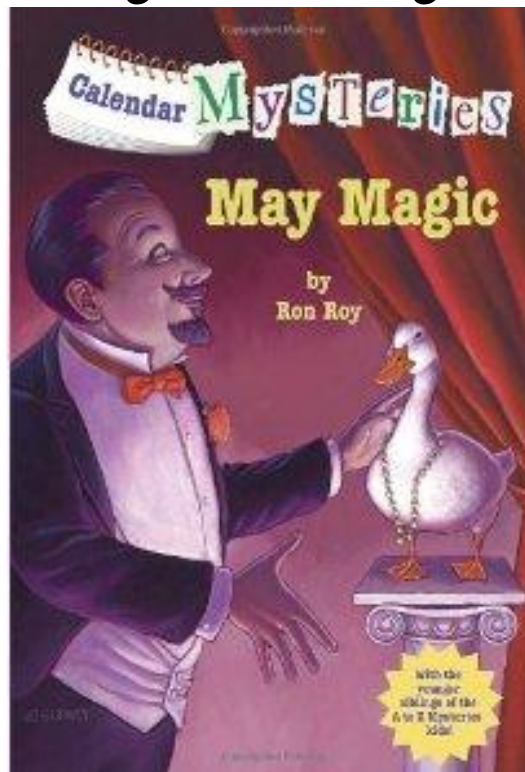

Detective Dictionary

Clue-a fact or object that helps to solve *mysteries*.

Crime-an act that is against the law.

Detective-a person who investigates *mysteries* and gathers information.

Evidence-something that proves who committed the *crime*.

Mystery-something that is secret and unknown.

Suspect-a person who is believed to have committed a *crime*.

Victim-someone who is harmed or suffers some loss because of the *crime*.

Witness-someone who saw the *crime* being committed and can provide some information.

- A secret.
- Something that is lost or missing.
- A crime that has been committed.

Clues:

- Hints that help the reader and the detective solve the mystery.

Solution:

- The mystery is solved.
